

## Athletic Center General Facility Policies & Regulations

- ❖ All patrons must enter from the Main Entrance, check in and present proper ID to the Reception Monitor
- ❖ Proper ID/pass must be presented to lifeguards and fitness monitors
- ❖ Lost or stolen ID's can be replaced for \$5.00
- ❖ Proof of age is required
- ❖ **Parental supervision is required for youth under the age of 16 at all times with the exception of Teen Hours for teens 13 and up daily from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm and weekends from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm (gymnasium and pool privileges only) or enrollment in a specified program**
- ❖ Users assume normal risks; **NYCC does not carry medical/accident insurance for members**
- ❖ Lockers are available daily. Locks remaining after hours will be cut. A \$3.00 per day fee is charged for remaining items
- ❖ Non-scuffing athletic shoes must be worn on all indoor athletic courts; street shoes and any and all spike shoes are prohibited
- ❖ Food/drink restricted to the Snack Lounge
- ❖ Smoking is prohibited
- ❖ NYCC is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- ❖ Animals are prohibited from the campus
- ❖ Radios and boom boxes are prohibited, headsets may be used
- ❖ Bicycles are prohibited in the building. Bike racks are provided
- ❖ Rollerblades, roller skates or skateboards are not allowed in Athletic Center or on outdoor tennis courts
- ❖ Slam dunking and hanging on rims is prohibited
- ❖ Softballs, hardballs, footballs, soccer balls, lacrosse balls may not be used in the gym without approval and the gym must be properly set up to accommodate such activities
- ❖ All motor driven vehicles are to park in Parking Lot F
- ❖ Use of the Athletic Center is a privilege. Acceptable conduct must be observed at all times. Anyone violating policies, misusing equipment or engaging in inappropriate behavior, including verbal and physical abuse of employees or patrons, is subject to immediate removal and loss of membership privileges. No refunds will be granted.
- ❖ Students are governed by NYCC student policy. If a student loses his/her ID card for the purpose of utilizing the Athletic Center, the student will be given a pass to the Athletic Center valid for a time period of two (2) business days until their photo ID card is replaced by Security. The pass will be dated with the specific time frame it is valid for. In the event the student is utilizing the temporary pass for the Athletic Center, they will not be allowed to check out equipment with it. This procedure will be allowed **ONCE PER TRIMESTER!**

## Equipment Check-Out

Athletic and recreational equipment may be borrowed from the Equipment Room by NYCC students, faculty and staff and community membership holders upon presentation of a valid identification card. Some of the equipment available includes basketballs, volleyball equipment, tennis equipment, racquetball equipment and jump ropes. Footballs, soccer balls, softballs, bats and bases are available **for outdoor use only**. Equipment must be returned the same day unless arrangements are made with the Recreational Services Office.

All overnight loans must be reserved at least two full working days in advance. Equipment loans require a \$10.00 deposit unless the value of the equipment exceeds \$75.00, then a \$20.00 deposit is required. All overnight loans must be transacted between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday only, in the Recreational Services Office. Weekday loans must be returned by 11:30 am the next day. Weekend loans must be picked up on Friday before 3:30 pm and returned no later than 11:30 am on Monday. A \$2.00 per day late charge is assessed for overdue equipment.

To check out equipment you need to possess a current NYCC student, faculty or staff identification card or current Athletic Center membership card. You are required to leave your identification and telephone number on the equipment checkout card.

Only NYCC students can check out cross country skis and they must sign a release waiver first before they can use the skis.

### **Lockers**

Locker rentals are available to New York Chiropractic College students, faculty, staff and community members who are current membership holders to the Athletic Center. Each Locker Room has a number of lockers designated for rental purposes as well as lockers designated for general usage on a daily basis for those not wishing to purchase Locker Permits. **No overnight locks are permitted on lockers used on a daily basis.**

Locker Permits may be purchased in the Recreational Services Office weekdays during the hours of 8:30 am and 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. All combinations will be kept in the Recreational Services Office. Access to locker combinations will not be available during hours of operation on weekends.
