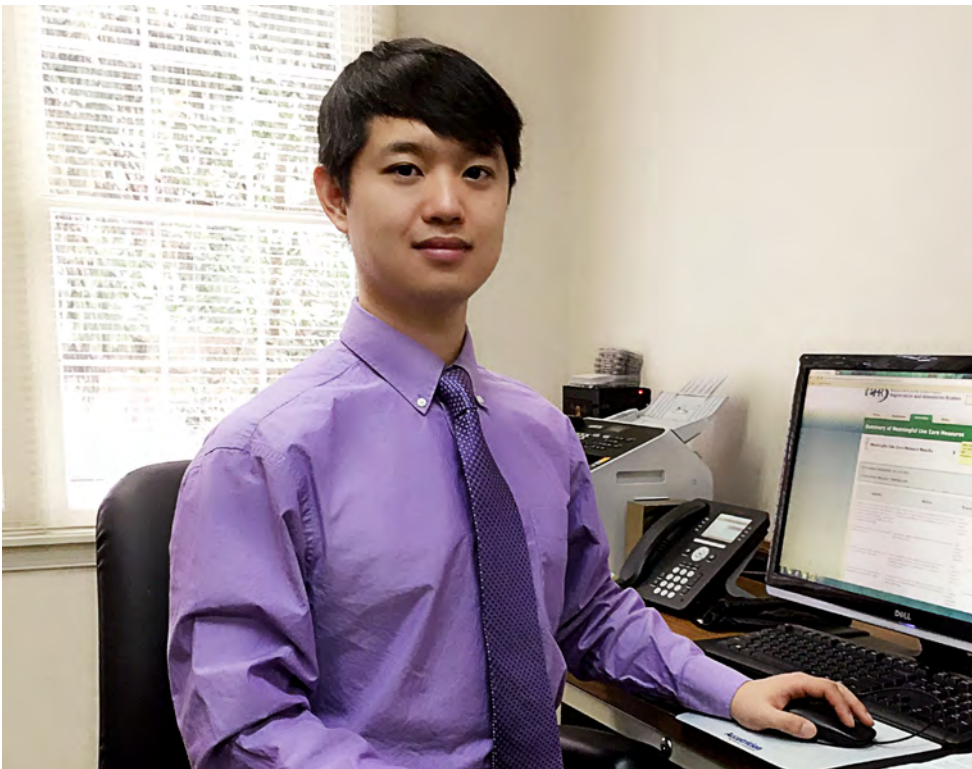


WHO IS NYCC?

DR. BIBO ZHANG graduated from New York Chiropractic College's Doctor of Chiropractic program in the fall of 2013. While completing his bachelor's degree in traditional Chinese medicine (TCM) at Liaoning University in China, as well as a master's degree in pediatric TCM, he met several chiropractors and was fascinated by what they did.
