



# Common Questions about Your New Home Away From Home

## How big are the rooms?

The bedrooms are approximately 12'x16'. The suite lounges in Mohawk, & Oneida are about 10'x12'. In Huron, Onondaga & Tuscarora, the suite lounges are approximately 16'x17'.

## What furniture is already in the room?

The bedrooms have a bed, desk, desk chair, dresser, and closet. The suite lounge has a couch, a small kitchen-type table and 4 chairs.

## What size is the bed?

The bed is a twin extra-long. Twin extra long sheets are recommended, although you may be able to get a deep pocket regular twin sheet to fit. The mattress is approximately 80 inches long.

## Can I bring my own bed?

Yes, you can (as long as it isn't a waterbed-they're not allowed)! If you bring your own furniture, it is your responsibility to move the College furniture assigned to your room into the storage area of the building and to make sure it is returned to your room when you move off-campus.



## Does the room have curtains?

The room windows already have drapes, so you don't have to worry about privacy.

## Are the rooms carpeted?

Yes! The suites are completely carpeted except for the bathroom.

## Do I need to bring any other furniture?

I would recommend getting here and seeing how things fit in the room before you bring anything too large. However, some items that you will probably want to remember are room lights or lamps, a fan, a phone and maybe a nightstand or small table. And don't forget the essentials such as soap, shampoo, toilet paper, etc.

## Can I bring a small fridge or microwave?

There is a full size (22 cubic ft) refrigerator in the suite lounge, but you can also have a smaller fridge in your room. It must be 6 cubic feet or smaller. You may also bring a microwave, but don't forget there is a full kitchen in the basement of each building!

## Is there cable TV?

Cable TV lines are located in each bedroom and in the suite lounge. This is a free service provided by the College. Just hook up your TV!

## Is there internet access from my room?

The residence halls are equipped with high speed wireless service. To receive this service, you need to have a wireless card in your computer (or other devices). Most recently-purchased computers come equipped with this card already installed. But if yours doesn't, these cards are widely available in the Bookstore or from outside vendors. If you do not have a computer or printer, there is an on-campus computer lab that is open various hours Monday through Saturday.
